

Guidance for choir members

As a choir members are responsible for your own health and well-being. You need to make your own decision about whether to attend rehearsals and make that decision each week.

Please do not attend if you feel at all unwell, have any Covid related symptoms, if you have tested positive, if you have been told to self-isolate or if you have had close contact with someone with Covid 19 (until you have had a negative test yourself).

Rehearsals will resume on Thursday 9th September in St. John's Church (better ventilation and easier for distancing).

We aim to begin singing at 8 pm but please arrive earlier to allow time for registration, collection of music and seating arrangements.

We expect that the vast majority of the choir will be double vaccinated. If you are not, we encourage you to take a lateral flow test prior to attending rehearsals.

Rehearsals will initially be for one hour only.

Everyone will be required to register on arrival at rehearsal.

Sanitiser will be provided but feel free to bring your own.

Masks will not be compulsory but individuals may choose to wear them.

The choir will be spaced to take account of social distancing.

A Covid risk assessment will be in place and available for anyone who wishes to see it.

There will not be a tea break and the kitchen will not be open so please bring your own drinks if required.
